



Little Sister Program

The Distinguished Young Women of Taylor County Little Sister Program is for young ladies ages 6 to 10 (birth certificate will be required). The purpose of this program is to mentor those young ladies who have an interest in the DYW of Taylor County program and promoting community service when they are incoming seniors. Participating DYW candidates will serve as a Big Sister to the Little Sisters Program. The current DYW of Taylor County participants will serve as mentors to the Little Sisters. All Little Sisters will participate in some aspect of the stage production at the 2020 DYW of Taylor County Program in September. Little Sisters will also be recognized in the DYW of Taylor County program book.

Each Little Sister is to provide her own white dress (short, tea length, or “Sunday-best” are all appropriate choices) and flat shoes. The dress must be ALL white (no rhinestones, silver, gold, or colored stones, sequins, etc) and appropriate for the age of the young lady. Little Sisters will also need to provide solid white shorts, white socks, and white tennis shoes that will be worn on stage. Each little sister will sit in a designated area with one parent. One adult female will need to meet in a designated dressing area to change the little sister from shorts to white dress. Each little sister will need to submit a head shot photo by email for the 2020 DYW of Taylor County program book to stephajohnson76@yahoo.com, no later than Sunday, May 5, 2019.

Registration fee is \$75 which includes t-shirt for the little sister, pizza party with your DYW Big Sister, 1 ticket for the program, Saturday, September 21, 2019 and a program book. All little sisters will be required to attend 2 practices. Sunday, September 15, 4:30 pm - 6:00 pm will be the first practice held at the Taylor County High School Auditorium. During this practice there will be a meeting with the parents to answer any questions or to give updates regarding the program. On Friday, September 20, 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm there will be dress rehearsal for the Little Sisters at Taylor County High School Auditorium. One adult female will need to be present for outfit change. Please bring all clothes for the program on the dress rehearsal night. The fee and application are due no later than Sunday, May 5, 2019.
